BY MAIL

Alaska allows any registered voter to vote by mail if they apply for a by-mail ballot.

Voting by mail is safe!

PERSONAL REP

Are you unable to vote in person because of age, illness or a disability? If so, you may have someone pick up and deliver a ballot to you.

Your personal representative may pick up a ballot for you at any absentee voting location in your area starting 15 days before Election Day or at your polling place.
